MINUTES OF DECEMBER MARAC MEETING

The regular meeting of MARAC was held at the qth of WØSJE, Dec 5, 1970 at 8:15 PM. Members present were: WAGWOB, WGSJE, KGAYO, WAGKQQ, WGAYL, WAGSHE, WGYLN, K8DCR and WAØSLG. The meeting was called to order by the president, WAØWOB. The minutes of the November meeting were accepted as presented to the members in the newsletter. A discussion followed regarding applying for a club call. KØAYO, who holds an extra class license will be custodian. The cost of the newsletter was discussed in order to arrive at our actual cost for each publication. It was also discussed whether to have the newsletter available to non-members or keep the newsletter for members only. It was decided to present this to the membership in this months newsletter for a consensus with a policy to be set and announced in next months newsletter. WØSJE gave a report on the number of awards issued to date and of the interest in members who are presently working toward the awards. He also presented his draft for the DX mobile award. It is now ready for the finished art work, then will be sent to the printer. W.M.ØSHE was asked to bring up pending items from past minutes: The box number that had been tabled was again tabled as it does not appear to be necessary at this time. The 3079 last county award will have high priority as soon as we have the DX award ready and sufficient revenue is generated from existing awards. The ballots for the net control operator and mobile operator trophies will be sent out with the April newsletter. A return deadline for the ballots will be June 1. The executive board will count the ballots at the June meeting. The plaques will be presented at the July meeting. Those Charter members who have not received their MAHAC name tags will have them presented in July. The membership at this time is: 97 Charter members. 41 regular members and 5 associate members. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:37. The next regular meeting will be held Jan 2 at the qth of WOYLN. All local members are asked to attend. Any member who might be in the vicinity are invited to join us. Meeting places are subject to change when circumstances necessitate a change. It is advisable to check with local members on location of meeting.

FROM THE EDITOR

The gang in KC wishes all the very best for a happy holiday season and "may SANTA CLAUS leave that last contact for some coveted award in your stocking!" One of the original objectives of MARAC was, and continues to be, the promotion of better mobile operation. In line with these objectives we have compiled a draft of guide lines for mobile operation on the various county hunters nets. Guidelines for net controllers is in preparation, as is a list of suggestions for the guidance of the fixed stations on the nets. These come from the many letters received from our members as well as our own discussions on the matter. We plan to submit these drafts for discussion at the ICHN KC71 convention in hope that a committee can develop a resolution, perhaps using these drafts as a basis, which can become guidelines for better ICHN operation. The first one of these drafts is included in this newsletter and the others will follow as space permits.

Originally, we announced that we would make the newsletter available to anyone at a price of one dollar for the remainder of our year, or until April, 1971 on a trial basis. We have 5 stations now that receive the newsletter under these conditions. It appears that we may have more. As we all know, the prices on everything has gone up and is continuing to go up and to offer the newsletter under these terms would be to do so at a loss, since it costs approximately #1.75 a year per station now under the present postal rates. (We understand these rates are due to go up). Three options are listed below and we solicit

your opinion so that we may announce the one decided on in the January, 1971 newsletter:

- Continue the newsletter as is to non-member stations at a cost of \$2.00 per year (April to May). Beginning immediately, all applications for the newsletter to be honored as a full year after January 1; 1971.
- Charge a flat rate of \$3.00 per year to all, letting the non-member stations decide if he wants membership or just the newsletter.
- Make the newsletter available to members only.

In accordance with provisions in MARAC Constitution, "to recognize and award outstanding accomplishments in Amateur Radio with emphasis on mobile operation", MARAC members are being given this opportunity to select their choices for MARAC Net Control of the year and MARAC Mobile operator of the year (70-71). A plaque will be presented at the MARAC meeting KC-71. Deadline for returning your ballot will be 1 July, 71. Ballots will be included with the April newsletter. We ask that the selecting be held in confidence and not discussed on the air. The winners need not be present or a member of MARAC. Our rules state that the Net Control award may be won by the same station but the Mobile Award only once by the same station. Since K7WQJ won the Mobile award last year, he will not be eligible for any more. In making your selections we suggest you consider the following:

NET CONTROL

- 1. Does he hold control of the net.
- 2. Does he keep "his cool" on the air.
- Does he recognize and arrange for all check-ins promptly.
- 4. Does use a minimum amount of conversation.
- 5. Does he use courteous speech.
- 6. Does he remain impartial.

- Does he keep "his cool".
- 2. Does he use good operating procedure.
- 3. Does he have good signal
- 4. Does he adjust to net conditions.
- 5. Does he QSL.
